Further and Higher Education

Birmingham City University – Town Planning advisor for over 10 years, covering various capital projects and estate management issues across the University's estate. Major capital projects include: outline planning permission for 120,000 sq.m expansion of the City Centre Campus at Eastside Locks, and 10,000 sq.m expansion of the City South Campus in Edgbaston.
