Profile

David is a dual qualified Chartered Surveyor and Chartered Town Planner with 25 years private sector consultancy experience. David provides expert advice on matters relating to town planning, development promotion and asset management. He has particular expertise in planning strategy, multi-discipline team working, major planning application project co-ordination, and environmental impact assessment. He has an extensive track record of working in the industrial/distribution, residential and education sectors.

David founded Delta Planning in 2011 following a successful career working for national property and planning consultancies. Immediately prior to starting the practice he had spent 6 years as a Director of Turley Associates in Birmingham. Prior to that he had spent 10 years with Fuller Peiser (now BNP Paribas) where he helped grow the regional planning business and headed the Birmingham team from 1999.

Example achievements and projects include:

- Prologis UK, Various Employment Parks: Preparation and coordination of planning applications including
 environmental impact assessments for major distribution/employment parks at Wellingborough, Lichfield,
 Ryton, Bradford, Stoke, and Barnsley totaling nearly 7 million sq.ft (over 400 acres) of development.
